

We will expand the types of genres as we move forward.



To uncover the plot of your story, don't ask what should happen but what should go wrong. To uncover the meaning of your story, don't ask what the theme is, but rather, what is discovered. Characters making choices to resolve tension—that's your plot. If your protagonist has no goal, makes no choices, or has no struggle to overcome, you have no plot.


