



WRITING TIP

Knowing what your protagonist desires is vital. If you don't know what she wants (or thinks she wants), then you won't know what your story is actually about. However, it's not essential to know all of this before you start to write or even as you work on early drafts of your story. WANT TO GET INSIDER INFO BEFORE ANYONE ELSE?

An Interview with Author & Instructor Steven James

Here are a few things to know about Steven and his newest writing book <u>DELVE, PIVOT, PROPEL</u>:

1. What are the most important lessons you'd like writers to take away from Delve, Pivot, Propel?

A couple things pop to mind: (1) How to abandon your outline to write faster and create more poignant stories. (2) Understand that every scene of your book should include a Pivot, because without it you will either write something that is too predictable, too outlandish, or too nonsensical. Pivots are absolutely essential to effective storytelling. (3) Realize that stories are not lists of things that happen—that's a report. Stories are much less about a progression of events and much more about a collision of desires.



2. What is the most common mistake writers make when writing their first draft? What about for editing?

Ha! Well, they plan too much instead of letting the story inform them about where it should go. We also tend to tug our characters around on a leash, trying to get them here and there and to the next plot point. I encourage you to cut the leash and let them act without restraint, in honest ways. That's when the stories start to get interesting. As far as editing, you might be surprised that I encourage people to edit as they go rather than consciously ignoring problems with the book while plowing through to the end. I'm much more interested in addressing issues as they arise than I am in pretending they're not there and just plodding forward into the story.

3. After appearing at more than 2000 events worldwide, what is the highest number your frequent flyer mile balance has hit?

I think I'm at about 850,000 miles on the airline that I fly the most. So, lots of cramped-legroom writing and reading going on.

4. What did your parents think when you pursued storytelling as your Bachelors/Masters degrees?


I actually have an undergrad degree in outdoor recreation and a master's in storytelling. So, one degree in how to play and the other in how to tell a story. My parents were supportive, but I have to say that they were a

bit surprised!


5. Anything else?

I just really hope people will turn away from formulaic fiction and let their stories breathe. If they learn to do that from this book, I'll consider it a resounding success.

Steven James is the bestselling author of twenty novels that have received wide critical acclaim. His books have won or been shortlisted for dozens of national and international awards, and he has taught writing and storytelling principles on five continents, appearing more than 2,000 times over the past three decades.






